BACKGROUND:

At our last council meeting the council voted to enter into a non-binding letter of intent with Enviro Board. The Council desires to sell Lot 28 located at the Grant County Industrial Park Subdivision to Enviro Board Corporation of Camden, New Jersey or a limited liability company affiliated with Enviro Board Corporation. Enviro Board has developed a milling process that converts agriculture waste fiber into low-cost, environmentally-friendly building panels that may be used for a variety of residential structures. Enviro Board will construct a 25,000 – 50,000 square foot LEED industrial building on the property and will then occupy the property to operate five production lines which will produce the environmentally-friendly building panels.

ORS 221.725 states when a city council considers it necessary or convenient to sell real property or any interest therein, the city council shall publish a notice of the proposed sale in a newspaper of general circulation in the city, and shall hold a public hearing concerning the sale prior to the sale.

Attached is the notice of public hearing which ran in the September 5, 2012 edition of the Blue Mtn. Eagle. The public notice was also announced on KJDY radio station and on the City of John Day's website.

The hearing is scheduled to begin at 7 p.m.; in accordance with ORS 221.725, any City resident will have the opportunity to present written or oral testimony at the public hearing.

RECOMMENDATION:

The John Day City Council opens the public hearing as per ORS 221.725. The nature of the proposed sale and the general terms thereof, including an appraisal or other evidence of the market value of the property, shall be fully disclosed by the city council at the public hearing. Any resident of the city shall be given an opportunity to present written or oral testimony at the hearing.

- 2. Attached is a letter and Quit Claim Deeds from Jim Carpenter regarding the John Day Middle School Property. Quit Claim Deed Document #20121802 is the Canton Street side; Document #20121799 is for the Bridge Street side.
- 3. Public Works Director Dave Holland and I met with ODOT Project Manager Sean Maloney, Lead Roadway Design Engineer Mark Kightlinger, P.E and ODOT Surveyor for pre-project meeting on August 29, 2012. ODOT survey crew is tentatively scheduled to begin the survey work in the middle of September 2012. Sean will provide a public service announcement to let people know about the surveyors being in the area using the local newspaper and radio station.
