Grant Contract

BACKGROUND:

On August 17, 2015 the City of John Day received a \$200,000.00 check from Meyer Memorial Trust Fund of The Oregon Community Foundation to build a community room and kitchen in the City's new fire station.

Funds the City has received or have been secured for the community room are as follows:

In addition we have applied for a \$40,000 grant with The Collins Foundation; they are currently reviewing our application and have contacted me with some follow-up questions. We are also looking into another grant application with the Joyce Miller Owens Charitable Foundation. This foundation is associated with Azure Farms in Dufur, which is why the Dufur Fire Station received funding. Mayor Ron Lundbom informed me that Azure Farms also owns property in Kimberly and Monument, so we may have a connection that would provide them an incentive to consider funding in John Day.
