5. DIRECT INVESTMENT	Green presented two options for investing in housing projects: direct investment or leveraging funds through a lender. Loran Joseph expressed support for leveraging funds but emphasized the importance of finding a partner lender who understands R3's structure and role. The speakers discussed the challenges of building affordable housing in unserved markets and the need to manage construction and credit risk.	No motions
6. IMPLEMENTATION SUPPORT	Green provided context on the projects identified for the communities and suggested starting with those projects before inviting applications from outside the community. The speakers discussed the possibility of expanding the projects beyond the four R3 cities and the need to be cautious in selecting projects. They also discussed the importance of having an independent perspective on the Board and contacting people in other counties to apply for the position. Finally, they agreed to leave the at-large application window open for another 30 days and see if they get more applicants by December.	No motions

- * How can we allocate funds and set limits for the initial projects to avoid overspending?
- * How can we demonstrate our success to the state and secure more funding?
- * What metrics can we use to determine if the housing projects are successful?

Action Items:

- * Nick Green will
 - Refine the task order for predevelopment technical assistance and discuss it in the December meeting;
 - Invoice R3 for monthly administrative fees;
 - Request a proposal from a home designer for creating home plans that can be used across multiple communities;
 - Identify a lender to partner with for leveraging funds for direct investments;
 - Draft joint development agreements for the R3 listed projects (in the IGA) and evaluate the possibility of opening up applications to other cities;
 - Run financials on the projects and determine the capital outlay budget by December;
 - Provide options for commercial real estate investment loans.
