- Alternative C – Wastewater Storage Lagoons with Mechanical Treatment Facility

3. Review Wastewater Disposal Options

- Class A reuse – purple pipe system (See Figure 4-8)
- Winter disposal
 - Administrative Extension of WPCF Permit
 - NPDES permit
 - ASR (Aquifer Storage and Recovery)

4. Review of Possible Funding Sources

- Wastewater Treatment Facility
 - BO (Business Oregon)
 - CDBG (Community Development Block Grant)
 - DEQ (Department of Environmental Quality)
 - RD (U.S. Department of Rural Development)
- Purple Pipe System
 - OWRD (Oregon Water Resources Department)
- Riparian Corridor

- BPA (Bonneville Power Administration)
- USFW (US Fish and Wildlife)
- OWEB (Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board)
