The City of John Day, City of Canyon City and Grant County, in accordance with National Flood Insurance Program regulation 65.7(b)(1), hereby gives notice of the Cities' and County's intent to revise the flood hazard information, generally located between within and adjacent to the Cities' urban growth boundaries. Specifically, the flood hazard information shall be revised along the John Day River from a point approximately one-half mile north of the intersection of Highway 26 and La Costa Rd (County Rd 85) to a point approximately 800 feet northeast of the intersection of Highway 26 and Dog Creek Rd. Flood hazard information shall also be revised along Canyon Creek from its mouth at the John Day River to a point approximately one-third mile south of the intersection of Highway 395 and County Rd 51.

As a result of the revision, the floodway shall widen and narrow (at various locations), the 1% annual chance water-surface elevations shall increase, and the 1% annual chance floodplain shall widen and narrow (at various locations) within the area of revision.
