

RESOLUTION 90-295-12
TRANSIENT ROOM TAX CLOSE
AUTHORIZATION

WHEREAS Grant County has now been authorized to collect Transient Room Tax and the City of John Day has discontinued their Transient Room Tax, and

WHEREAS the purpose of each of these taxes were to promote the tourism and economic development for the area, and

WHEREAS the City of John Day had intended that the funds available be used for those purposes and to avoid duplication in efforts;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby authorize the closing of the Transient Room Tax Fund by payment of any monies left in the fund to Grant County and the transfer of the encumbrance (commitment) in the amount of \$5,000.00 for the sodding of the Little League field area after the withholding of any and all expenses incurred by the City for the fund's operation in FY91; with such transfer(s) to be made as expeditiously as possible.
