Pursuant to ORS 656.041, workers' compensation coverage will be provided to community service volunteers commuting their sentences by performing work authorized by:

Oregon minimum wage tracked hourly will be used for both premium and benefit calculations, verifiable by providing a copy of the roster and/or sentencing agreement from the court.

7. Other Volunteers

Volunteer exposures not addressed here will have workers' compensation coverage if, prior to the onset of the work provided that The City of John Day:

- a. Provides at least two weeks' advance written notice to CIS underwriting requesting the coverage
- b. CIS approves the coverage and date of coverage
- c. CIS provides written confirmation of coverage

The City of John Day agrees to maintain verifiable rosters for all volunteers including volunteer name, date of service, and hours of service and make them available at the time of a claim or audit to verify coverage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF JOHN DAY TO PROVIDE WORKERS' COMPENSATION COVERAGE AS INDICATED ABOVE.
