**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING** 

The City of John Day is eligible to apply for a 2020 Community Development Block Grant from the Business Oregon. Community Development Block Grant funds come from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The grants can be used for public facilities and housing improvements, primarily for persons with low and moderate incomes.

Approximately \$12 million will be awarded to Oregon non-metropolitan cities and counties in 2020. The maximum grant that a city or county can receive for a public works project is \$2,500,000. The City of John Day is preparing an application for a 2020 Community Development Block Grant from Business Oregon for Construction of Wastewater System Improvements: Design project.

A virtual public hearing will be held by the John Day City Council at 7 P.M. on August 11, 2020. The purpose of this hearing is for the City Council to obtain citizen views and to respond to questions and comments about the scope of the proposed projects. Main Street, John Day, OR 97845. Both oral and emailed comments (email: <a href="mailto:cityofjohnday@grantcounty-or.gov">cityofjohnday@grantcounty-or.gov</a>) will be reviewed by the City Council. It is estimated that the project will benefit at least 2,440 persons of whom 57.3% are low or moderate income. The service area for the City's wastewater utility includes both John Day and Canyon City and the low or moderate income demographics apply to both communities.
