Here are some reminders from the closing conference:

- You have the right to present pertinent information regarding the violations.
- The above information in this email describes the alleged violations and penalties assessed.
- Abatement times are listed in the table above.
- Two hazard letters were issued, related to heat illness and housekeeping in the vicinity of asbestos containing materials
- Citations are issued from Salem via certified mail. https://osha.oregon.gov/rules/enf/Pages/citations.aspx
- Letter of corrective action will be sent with citation and it will show the due date. Please fill out, provide proof, and send back following the instructions. You may also scan and email back to me for faster processing.
- Failure to abate violation may result in daily penalties.
- You must post the citation at your place of work for a minimum of 3 days or until abated. (post only where employees can see, public does not need to see)
- You have the right to appeal any/all violations/penalty/abatement times etc. I am here to assist with appealing (if applicable).
- Citations become final order if not appealed with 30 days of receipt.
- Appeals need to be in writing within 30 days. https://osha.oregon.gov/rules/enf/Pages/appeals-process.aspx
- Appeals can be in form of informal conference at field office or by phone or a formal hearing.
- Abatement assistance is readily available by calling me, or anyone at OR-OSHA.

- One referral was made to the Oregon DEQ.
- Employee(s) who participated in the inspections (e.g. interviews) are protected from discrimination by (BOLI).

- Work-related fatality or catastrophe requires notification to OSHA within 8 hours. <u>Oregon Occupational Safety and Health: Report a fatality or injury:</u> Employer essentials: State of Oregon
