

RESOLUTION NO. 23-908-08

A RESOLUTION OF CITY OF JOHN DAY REVOKING THE LIMITED ADMINISTRATIVE AND MANAGERIAL AUTHORITY GRANTED TO THE MAYOR (AND HIS OR HER DESIGNEE(S)) UNDER RESOLUTION NO. 23-901-01.

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2023 the John Day City Council adopted Resolution No. 23-901-01 (the "Delegation Resolution"), pursuant to which the council temporarily authorized Mayor Heather Rookstool (and her designee(s)) to perform certain city manager administrative duties and responsibilities until the earlier of (a) her vacancy, removal from office, or term expiration, or (b) the council's decision to revoke the authority through council resolution; and

WHEREAS, the council anticipates that a city manager will be employed effective no later than January 2, 2024; and

WHEREAS, due to fulfillment of the city manager position, the council finds it necessary and appropriate to revoke (i.e., terminate) the limited authority granted under the Delegation Resolution.


NOW, THEREFORE, the City of John Day resolves as follows:

1. Findings. The above-stated findings contained in this Resolution No. 23-908-08 (this "Resolution") are hereby adopted.
2. Termination. In accordance with the Delegation Resolution, the council hereby unconditionally revokes (i.e., terminates) the authority granted to Mayor Heather Rookstool (and her designee(s)) under the Delegation Resolution effect as of January 1, 2024.
3. Miscellaneous. For purposes of this Resolution, the singular includes the plural and the plural includes the singular; the word "or" is not exclusive and the words "include," "includes," and "including" are not limiting. Any reference to a particular law, statute, rule, regulation, code, or ordinance includes the law, statute, rule, regulation, code, or ordinance as now in force and hereafter amended. The provisions of this Resolution are severable. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, and/or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid, unenforceable, and/or unconstitutional, such invalid, unenforceable, and/or unconstitutional section, subsection, sentence, clause, and/or portion will (a) yield to a construction permitting enforcement to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law, and (b) not affect the validity, enforceability, and/or constitutionality of the remaining portion of this Resolution. This Resolution may be corrected by order of the council to cure editorial and/or clerical errors. This Resolution will be in full force and effect from and after its approval and adoption.
