# ICA RODEO AUGUST 2 & 3 JR. RODEO AUGUST 4 FAIR AUGUST 7-10, 2024

Vendors are encouraged to submit their applications by **April 1, 2024**, as previous vendors are given first opportunity to contract for space. New vendors will have their applications held until after **May 1, 2024** at which time space will be assigned on what is available for the new vendors.

All vendors temporarily operating at any location on or within one-half (1/2) mile of the Fairgrounds must submit a Vendor Application and, upon approval, pay all required fees in order to be licensed

to operate. ORS 565.610. Operating without authorization from the Fair Board is a Class D felony subject to fines up to \$250 per violation. ORS 565.630; 153.018.

Please attach a complete list of ALL products you wish to display or sell. Once vendor application is accepted by the Fair Manager no product(s) may be added or removed without approval of Fair Manager. Make sure and list brand names and remember **NO EXCLUSIVITY SHALL BE GRANTED!**

## PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT, RULES AND REGULATIONS

### GENERAL INFORMATION

All vendors temporarily operating at any location on or within one-half (1/2) mile of the Fairgrounds must submit a Vendor Application and, upon approval, pay all required fees in order to be licensed to operate. ORS 565.610. Operating without authorization from the Fair Board is a Class D felony subject to fines up to \$250 per violation. ORS 565.630; 153.018. Violators will be required to shut down. Each time a vendor is cited for operating without a valid license constitutes a separate violation, with the possibility of incurring multiple violations in a single day. Violators who refuse to shut down may be arrested. ORS 565.640.

- The Fairgrounds will be open from 8 AM to 11PM each day of the Fair.
- Vendors agree to comply with rules and regulations of the Fair as stated in the annual County Fair Guide.
- **No drug-related items or tobacco products/paraphernalia will be allowed to be displayed or sold at the Grant County Fair.**
- **The Fairboard retains sole discretion as to booth placement, location, and space.**
- While every effort is made not to duplicate booths, participants will not be given an exclusive right by the Fair to sell, take orders, or demonstrate any service or product.
- Drawings are permitted by non-profit groups as long as they are in compliance with all the

Oregon State Statues and have received approval from the Fair. Drawings should only be held within the confines of your booth; no roving solicitation.

- All food concessionaires must be in compliance with Oregon State Health Department. The State Health Inspector will make an on-sight visit.
- Vendors cannot sublet their space.
- All booths, trailers, vans, etc., used on the grounds by concessionaires must be neatly constructed, clean, and of a pleasing appearance.
- All activity on grounds must be in accordance with State, County, and City ordinances.
- Participant agrees to cause no damage and will leave property in the same condition as it was prior to the event. Participant will make no alterations, additions, improvements, or changes to or upon said premises without consent of the Fair Office. Any and all approved installations and removal of any alterations, additions, improvements, or changes will be entirely at the expense of the Participants.
- Participants shall conduct themselves in a quiet and orderly manner at all times.



**INSURANCE**

**FOOD VENDORS** are required to provide a certificate of insurance covering the general liability with a ten-day notice of event. Coverage will be \$500,000 per occurrence with a \$1,000,000 aggregate. The Certificate shall name Grant County Fairgrounds, Grant County Fair Board, Grant County, their employees and agents as additional insured.

**FAIR SET-UP, TAKE DOWN**

- Pavilion can be set up starting one week prior to Fair, if no events are scheduled-contact Fair office with questions
- All indoor vendor booths must be set up and in place by 6:00 PM TUESDAY EVENING prior to Fair
- The Pavilion will close Tuesday to the public for judging and reopen on Wednesday at 10:00 AM.
- Exhibitors and vendors must be open daily through the Fair.
- All Outside Vendors may begin setup the Monday of Fair Week.

**INSIDE VENDORS AND OPEN CLASS HOURS OF OPERATION DURING THE FAIR.**

**Wednesday-Friday of Fair Week 10 AM ~ 8 PM**

**Saturday of Fair Week 12pm ~ 8 PM**

**(Fair Parade uptown at 11 AM)**

- The Pavilion will open to VENDORS ONLY on Saturday evening for tear down/cleanup 8:00-9:00 PM
- The Pavilion will be open again on Sunday morning after Fair from 8:00 to 12:00 noon for booth tear down/cleanup. The Pavilion is open all of the next week (after fair) 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM for completion of booth tear down and cleanup.

**OUTSIDE VENDOR/EXHIBITOR HOURS OF OPERATION DURING THE FAIR**

**Wednesday-Friday of Fair Week 10 AM ~ 11 PM**

**Saturday of Fair Week 11 AM ~ 11 PM**

- Vendors are to be setup and open to the public all hours of Fair and stay open longer if crowd stays for event

- Vendors can begin take down Sunday after Fair Vehicle(s) used for restocking booths will be permitted until 9:00 A.M daily. After 9:00 AM, deliveries made Thru the day must be carted to the booths either by hand carts, 4 wheeler or golf cart. Parking is available on 3rd street and on the side streets. No parking behind, in front or on sides of the booths.

**NOISE AND SOUND DEVICES AND STINK BOMBS**

**The use of stink bombs, gongs, bells, loudspeakers, microphones, and loud music of an offensive or disturbing nature is prohibited on the fairgrounds.**

**CANVASSING**

- Posting or distributing posters, handbills, and other advertising material is prohibited, except inside the booths of licensed exhibitors and concessionaires.
- Every concessionaire and agent shall work only in front of his own concession or booth and shall not be over four (4) feet from his concession or booth while working at the fair.
- No roving participant or solicitor acting for either a profit or non-profit organization or on his own behalf shall be permitted on the fairgrounds. All solicitations for either contributions or sale must be made from within the confines of a concession or booth unless otherwise exempted by the rules and regulations of the GC Fair Board.

**GARBAGE**

**Vendors are responsible for removing their garbage and placing in dumpster. Please flatten boxes and don't put in garbage containers. Please use dumpster located at Keerins Hall.**

**FAIR WILL PROVIDE GARBAGE BAGS!**

Please use durable garbage bags in the containers.

**SECURITY**

The Grant County Fair, Fair Board and Grant County do not assume responsibility for the safety of booths or other property of concessionaires or exhibitors, nor will they be held responsible for any loss incurred by concessionaire or exhibitor as a result of theft, fire, accident or other cause.



**FIREARMS, ETC**

Under no circumstances firearms or any other items that fall under this category or deemed unsafe be allowed for display or sale on the fairgrounds. If any such article or exhibit is discovered, such articles and persons responsible may be removed by order of the Fair.

**SMOKING**

**There is absolutely NO SMOKING or Vaping allowed in any facility or in or around your booth area(s). Smoking on the grounds is not allowed. Thank you for respecting this no smoking policy.**

*It is the vendor's obligations and responsibilities to follow all applicable laws, vendor is solely responsible for following, and ensuring compliance with, all laws, regulations and guidelines relating to the covid-19 pandemic.*

*The premises may not be used for purposes that violate federal, state, or local restrictions related to the covid-19 pandemic. Violation of this provision is grounds for immediate termination and the County will be entitled to recover front renter/tenant any and all costs, expenses, or damages related to noncompliance, including litigation costs and attorney fees.*

**REFUNDS**

- Space fee is due with your vendor application.
- If written notice of cancellation is received by July 15, 2024, 50% of the fee is refundable; if written notice is received by August 1, 2024 25% of the fee is refundable.
- No refund for cancellations after August 8, 2024. NO REFUNDS TO VENDORS WHO DO NOT SHOW UP.

*Participant's failure to comply with the terms and conditions of this agreement shall be cause for immediate termination of their agreement at the sole discretion of the Grant County Fair and, upon notification in writing of such termination, Participant shall vacate and forfeit all payment and space rights as liquidated damages without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to the fair.*
