NW Bridge Street Sidewalk Project

Construction for the Bridge Street Improvement Project began on September 26, 2007. Dice Construction was awarded the bid at the August 28, 2007 John Day City Council meeting.

This project originally began as an Oregon Department of Transportation grant for sidewalk improvements and a pedestrian bridge on the east side of NW Bridge Street. The project had several additions and now includes add-ons for repair of the sidewalks because of Oregon Trail Electric Cooperative (OTEC) moving their poles and some additional sidewalk placement.

The City received two bids as follows:

Winegar Excavation; total bid \$401,205.24. Dice Construction; Total bid \$399,850.50. Dice Construction has 90 days from the date of the signing of the contract to complete the project. The contract document was signed on September 4, 2007. The City of John Day appreciates everyone's patience during the construction period.

Automated Meter Reading System

At the June 26, 2007
John Day City Council meeting the John Day City Council unanimously voted to accept the bid for the automatic meter reading system from General Pacific utilizing the Orion software and Badger meters.

The department will

continue the installation of the new meters as time and weather allows during the winter months. The schedule is to have all installed before the spring reads.

Earlier in the month the office personnel and the Public Works Department were trained on the new system.

New Interim Public Works Director appointed

David Holland has been appointed interim Public Works Director for the City of John Day. David has been with the City of John Day since 1980 and has been the Public Works Foreman since 2002. The interim position will be evaluated at the end of the six-month period that began September 1, 2007.
