### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING – TYPE III PROCEDURE

Requested Action: Conditional Use Permit for John Day Recreational Bike Park

### **REQUEST**

The Grant School District #3 in coordination with the Grant County Economic Council (GCEC) is requesting a conditional use permit to create a recreational bike park on the property located at 13S31E23 Tax Lot 1100 (a seven acre parcel northeast of the 7<sup>th</sup> Street Complex). The conditional use would allow for bicycle and trail running on the proposed development. The property is zoned Residential General (RG).

# APPLICABLE CRITERIA

The City of John Day Development Code (the Code) allows parks and open space uses in the RG District when authorized by a conditional use permit (Table 5-2.2.020 – Land Uses Allowed in Residential Districts (RL, RG, RC). The permit may authorize parks and open space areas for outdoor recreation, including accessory uses such as club houses, maintenance facilities, concessions (as with athletic fields), caretaker's quarters and parking. Recreational trails are specifically listed as allowed uses within this category (Section 5-1.3.460 – Parks and Open Spaces).

All land use and development permit applications and approvals, except building permits, shall be decided by using the procedures contained in Chapter 5-4 of the Code. The procedure "type" assigned to each application governs the decision-making process for that permit or approval.

An application for a new conditional use shall be processed as a Type III procedure, per Section 5-4.1.040 of the Code. The application shall meet submission requirements in Section 5-4.4.030, and the approval criteria contained in Section 5-4.4.040.

# NOTICE REQUIREMENTS

The purpose of this notice is to give nearby property owners and other interested people the opportunity to submit written comments about the application before the Type III decision is made. The goal of this notice is to invite people to participate early in the decision-making process.

# If you would like to respond:

Written comments received or presented in person to Nicholas Green, City Manager, 450 East Main Street, John Day prior to May 3rd, 2017 by 4:00 p.m. will be considered in rendering a decision. Issues must be addressed with sufficient specificity based on criteria within the Code, upon which the Planning Commission must base its decision. Failure to address the relevant approval criteria with enough detail may preclude you to appeal to the Land Use Board of Appeals or Circuit Court on that issue. Only comments on the relevant approval criteria are considered relevant evidence. All evidence relied upon by the Planning Commission to make this decision is in the public record, available for public review. Copies of this evidence can be obtained at a reasonable cost from the City of John Day, 450 East Main Street, John Day, OR 97845.

The Planning Commission shall hold a <u>public hearing on May 4th, 2017 at 6:00 PM at the John Day Fire Station, 316 S. Canyon Blvd</u>. The Commission's decision shall be mailed to the applicant and to anyone else who submitted written comments or who is otherwise legally entitled to notice.


