

## **RESOLUTION NO.17-765-01**

### **A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RATES FOR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT, AND OTHER RELATED CHARGES.**

WHEREAS, the City of John Day has granted Clark's Disposal a non-exclusive franchise for the collection and hauling of solid waste; and

WHEREAS, Title 8, Chapter 3, Section 4 of the City Code of John Day, Oregon requires that rates charged by the franchisee for the collection and hauling of waste shall be established by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the franchisee has petitioned the Council for a rate increase for 2017;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by and through the City Council meeting in regular session, the maximum rates for the said franchise services as of January 1, 2017, are as follows:

#### **I. Residential Rates**

- 1) 32 Gallon Cans
  - \$16.50 per month for one can per week
  - \$27.50 per month for two cans per week
  - \$38.50 per month for three cans per week
  - \$3.50 special pick-up rate for an additional can
  - \$8.00 per month for one can per month
- 2) 45 Gallon Cans
  - \$20.00 per month for one can per week
- 3) Other Charges for Residential
  - \$1.00 per occurrence for extra boxes or bags

#### **II. Commercial Rates**

- 1) One Dump per Week
  - \$70.00 per cubic yard, per dump
  - \$97.50 per one and one-half cubic yards, per dump
  - \$125.00 per two cubic yards, per dump
- 2) Commercial Can Rates
  - Same as Residential Can rates described above
- 3) 100 Gallon Roll Cart


- \$20 per month for monthly service
- \$40.00 per month for weekly service

- 4) Roll-Offs and Drop Boxes
- 10-15 yards – \$100 Delivery Fee
  - 20-35 yards – \$52.50 Delivery Fee
  - Dump fee – \$0.05 per pound
  - Drop Box Rent – \$3.00 per day
  - Deposit of \$250 per account

- 5) Cardboard Container
- \$15.00 per month for one pickup per week
  - \$30.00 per month for two pickups per week

Any and all resolutions in conflict with the resolutions contained in this Resolution 17-765-01 are hereby superseded and repealed.
